

# VIRGINIA GLASS GUILD EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

## 2017 Educational Scholarship Guidelines

**Virginia Glass Guild** is offering \$2000 in educational scholarships this year. The award money will be payable directly to the school of the recipient's choice towards tuition, room and board for a glass art class. Members are eligible to apply for a scholarship if they have paid their dues for membership year 2017-2018, have been a member of the Guild for at least one year by the application deadline, and have not won VGG scholarship money from the previous year.

Applicants will provide a signed copy of this document, a copy of their resume and a proposal in PDF format. The proposal may take the form of either a letter of intent, 3-5 images of work, concept sketches, or any combination of the above. Must express, either visually or verbally, how this scholarship will be used to propel the applicant to the next stage in their artistic practice. If including photographs of past work, include title, dimensions and year. Any letter of intent should be no longer than 800 words. Including an artist statement and/or bio is optional but encouraged.

**Dr. Jutta-Annette Page**, Executive Director of the Barry Art Museum, Norfolk, Virginia, is the juror for our 30th Annual Juried Exhibition. She will review the applications and award the scholarships. Email all application materials to [vp@virginiaglassguild.org](mailto:vp@virginiaglassguild.org) no later than Sunday, September 17, 2017. Winners will be announced during the opening reception awards ceremony on Sunday, October 15<sup>th</sup>. Winners are responsible for applying to the school of their choice and delivering the invoice to the VGG Treasurer so payment can be made.

Scholarship funds will be available to recipients for the entire 2017-2018 calendar year. If award money has not been distributed by the end of 2017, the recipient will forfeit the scholarship. Winners are also required to make a presentation to the membership sharing knowledge or information on techniques gained from the class. The winner is expected to enter a piece of their artwork for auction in the 2018 Silent Auction, the Guild's primary fundraiser for scholarships. I agree to the above terms and conditions of the scholarship responsibilities.
